Student Drop Off and Pick Up

Supervision of students does not begin until 8:30am, so we would ask that, for safety's sake, students not be dropped at school before 8:30am.



Staff on premises before this time are usually involved in work preparation and prayer and are not able to supervise before this time.

Car Drop-Offs –For Safety's Sake

<u>Please</u> do not reverse in the car park when dropping off your child –there might be a little one behind your vehicle that you may not see. Move through the carpark in anti-clockwise direction from the entry to the exit gate. Drop your child on the OUTSIDE OF THE PORTICO and then drive forward.

If you have a child in Prep-K, who also has an older sibling, pick up in the afternoons should occur from the gate at the front of the Kindergarten classroom. We will have directed the older sibling to the K-room so that the children can be collected together.
