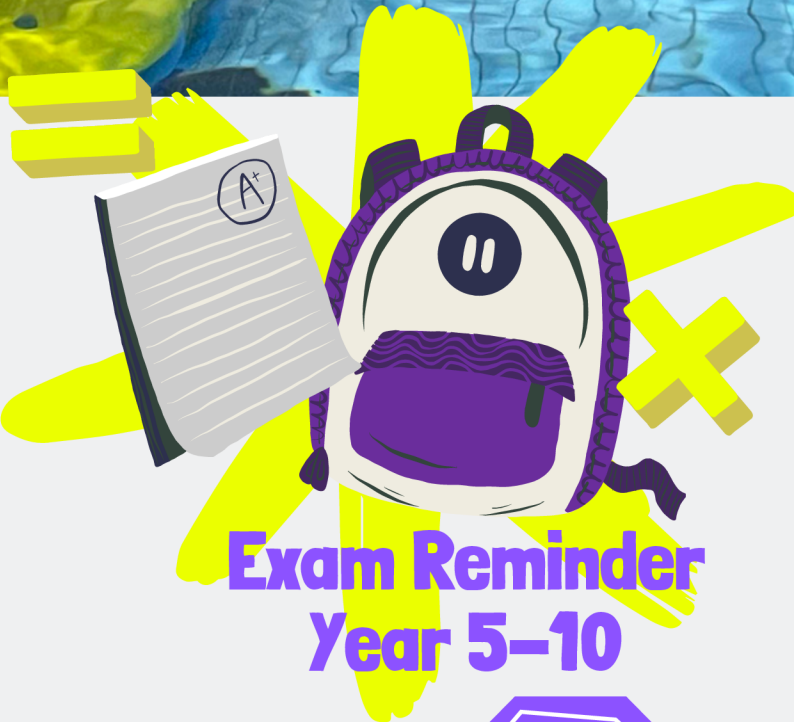

EXAMINATION AND ASSESSMENTS

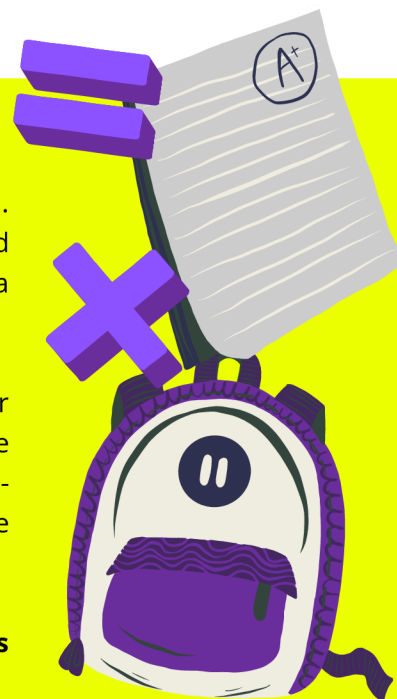

Students will be required to complete formal examinations at school for the next 8 years - through to the completion of Year 12, so they should be developing the skills they need for studying from now on.
